The Journey | Myths about the Afterlife | Luke 16:19-31



¹⁹ “There was a rich man who was clothed in purple and fine linen and who feasted sumptuously every day. ²⁰ And at his gate was laid a poor man named Lazarus, covered with sores, ²¹ who desired to be fed with what fell from the rich man’s table. Moreover, even the dogs came and licked his sores. ²² The poor man died and was carried by the angels to Abraham’s side. The rich man also died and was buried, ²³ and in Hades, being in torment, he lifted up his eyes and saw Abraham far off and Lazarus at his side. ²⁴ And he called out, ‘Father Abraham, have mercy on me, and send Lazarus to dip the end of his finger in water and cool my tongue, for I am in anguish in this flame.’ ²⁵ But Abraham said, ‘Child, remember that you in your lifetime received your good things, and Lazarus in like manner bad things; but now he is comforted here, and you are in anguish. ²⁶ And besides all this, between us and you a great chasm has been fixed, in order that those who would pass from here to you may not be able, and none may cross from there to us.’ ²⁷ And he said, ‘Then I beg you, father, to send him to my father’s house—²⁸ for I have five brothers—so that he may warn them, lest they also come into this place of torment.’ ²⁹ But Abraham said, ‘They have Moses and the Prophets; let them hear them.’ ³⁰ And he said, ‘No, father Abraham, but if someone goes to them from the dead, they will repent.’ ³¹ He said to him, ‘If they do not hear Moses and the Prophets, neither will they be convinced if someone should rise from the dead.’ ”

Digging Deeper (Read Luke 16:19-31)

On Sunday we examined some mistakes people make about the afterlife. Work through mistakes listed below.

Mistake #1) “*There is no afterlife.*”

- Who says this and why?
- What does Jesus say about this in our passage and elsewhere?
- How does this position conflict with our deep intuitions about justice?
- If true, how does this affect our definition for success in life? Where do you see that in this story?

Mistake #2) “*Everyone goes to heaven.*”

- Who says this and why?
- Some say that people in hell will eventually embrace Jesus and go to heaven.
- Where do you think they get this idea from?
- What does Jesus say in our passage and elsewhere that says otherwise.

Mistake #3) “*Good people go to heaven.*”

- Who says this and why?
- List some of the mistaken reasons to believe why the poor man is in heaven and the rich man in hell?
- What clues do you see in this passage *for why* the poor man is in heaven and the rich guy is in hell?

Mistake #4) “*Hell makes people better.*”

- Some are tempted to believe that people in hell finally realize the truth, are repentant, and want to get out but can't. What's wrong with this idea?
- What are some indicators the rich man never changed for the better?
- Although hell is a *punishment*, a *consequence*, and is *irreversible*, one of the ideas suggested Sunday is that it is preferred to heaven by those in it. Examine John 3:19-20 and discuss how this could be a possibility.

Mistake #5) “*Hell is proof that God is Unloving.*”

- Why would someone argue this?
- How does the gospel address this?
